Abstract: Exempts municipalities with a certain population level from a moratorium on additional beds for nursing facilities.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts a municipality with a population in excess of three hundred thousand persons as determined by the most recent federal decennial census from the moratorium on additional beds for nursing facilities provided in <u>present law</u>.
