3	(Port of New Orleans); to provide for membership in such system; to allow certain
4	retirees of other systems to be members of such system; to provide an effective date;

9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 11:3683(3)(b) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
11	§3683. Membership
12	The membership of the retirement system shall be composed as follows:

16	(b) Any employee who is employed on July 7, 2003, who has retired from
17	service under any retirement system of this state partly or wholly financed by public
18	funds, who is receiving retirement benefits therefrom, and who was prohibited from
19	becoming a member of this system upon his initial employment solely on this basis
20	shall become a member of this system prospectively only, beginning on July 17,
21	2003, and from the date of his initial employment provided he meets all other
22	eligibility requirements; however, any such employee may purchase credit for
23	previous service only in compliance with the provisions of R.S. 11:158 provisions
24	relating to actuarial calculation of purchase price.

1	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010; if vetoed by the governor
2	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
