INSURANCE: Provides qualifications for title insurance producers

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 22:513(B)(3), relative to individual title insurance producers; to  
3 modify relative to academic qualifications; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 22:513(B)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

6 §513. Title insurers and producers; qualifications

7 \* \* \*

8 B. The qualifications for each individual title insurance producer shall be as  
9 follows:

11 (3) Shall hold a high school diploma, a diploma for completion of a home  
12 study program approved by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education,  
13 ~~or~~ a high school equivalency diploma issued after successfully completing the test  
14 of general educational development, or a certificate, diploma, or degree from an  
15 accredited institution of postsecondary education.

**Abstract:** Adds postsecondary education credentials as academic qualifications for individual title insurance producers.

Present law provides certain academic qualifications for licensed title insurance producers. Requires a title insurance producer to have a high school diploma, a diploma for completion of an approved home study program, or a high school equivalency diploma.

Proposed law retains present law and adds a certificate, diploma, or degree from an accredited institution of postsecondary education as an academic qualifier for individual title insurance producers.
