Applicability 10 This Chapter shall not apply: * * 11 * 12 (16) To the following records of a board or institution of higher learning, in 13 accordance with rules and regulations promulgated by the Board of Trustees for State 14 Colleges and Universities, Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System, the 15 Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical 16 College, and the Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and 17 Mechanical College, or their successors, in conjunction with the Board of Regents, 18 for programs and institutions under their supervision and management, unless access 19 to the records is specifically required by state or federal statute or is ordered by a 20 court under rules of discovery: * 21 22 (e) Test questions, scoring keys, and other examination data pertaining to the 23 administration of an academic examination.
