PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS: Prohibits a hospital service district from using "construction management at risk" for projects estimated to cost less than two million dollars

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 38:2225.2.4(A)(3), relative to hospital service districts; to
3	exclude use of "construction management at risk" (CMAR) projects that cost less
4	than two million dollars; and to provide for related matters.

6	Section 1. R.S. 38:2225.2.4(A)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7	follows:
8	§2225.2.4. Construction management at risk; public entity

11	(3) CMAR shall not be used for any project that is estimated to cost less than
12	five million dollars, exclusive of a hospital service district as defined by R.S.
13	46:1072(2)(a) that may not use CMAR for any project estimated to cost less than two
14	million dollars. At least sixty days prior to proceeding to use CMAR for any project
15	that is estimated to cost less than fifteen million dollars, a public entity shall deliver
16	written notification of the proposed CMAR project by name and description of the
17	project, together with the reason to use CMAR, to the House and Senate
18	transportation, highways, and public works committees for review and approval.

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Abstract: Prohibits the use of "construction management at risk" for projects that cost less than two million dollars for hospital service districts.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits "construction management at risk" (CMAR) from being used for any project that is estimated to cost less than \$5,000,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds an exception for hospital service districts as defined by <u>present law</u>, which may not use CMAR for projects that cost less than \$2,000,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the requirement in <u>present law</u> for House and Senate transportation, highways and public works committee review and approval for CMAR projects costing between \$5,000,000 and \$15,000,000.

- 1. Remove the requirement in <u>present law</u> for House and Senate transportation, highways and public works committee review and approval for CMAR projects costing between \$5,000,000 and \$15,000,000.
