PROCUREMENT: Provides relative to state procurement

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 39:1554(B), relative to procurement; to provide for the
3 application of the Louisiana Procurement Code; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 39:1554(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

6 §1554. Application of this Chapter

7 * * *

8 B. Application to state procurement. (1) Except as provided in Subsections
9 C and D below, this Chapter shall apply to every expenditure of public funds
10 irrespective of their source, including federal assistance monies except as otherwise
11 specified in Subsection F below, by this state, acting through a governmental body
12 defined herein, under any contract for supplies, services, or major repairs defined
13 herein, except that this Chapter shall not apply to either grants or contracts between
14 the state and its political subdivisions or other governments, except as provided in
15 Part VII (Intergovernmental Relations). Notwithstanding any other provision of this
16 Chapter, the provisions of R.S. 38:2181 through R.S. 38:2316 shall govern the
17 procurement of construction and the selection of architects, engineers, and landscape
18 architects by governmental bodies of this state, and R.S. 38:2181 through R.S.
19 38:2316 shall not apply to any procurement of supplies, services, or major repairs by

1 the state except that the provisions of R.S. 38:2301 shall be applicable to major
2 repairs.

3 (2) This Chapter shall apply to any public nonprofit corporation created in
4 law.

Abstract: Specifies the application of the Louisiana Procurement Code to certain nonprofits.

Present law (Louisiana Procurement Code) applies to every expenditure of public funds by the state, acting through a governmental body, under any contract for supplies, services, or major repairs.

Proposed law retains present law and further specifies that present law applies to any public nonprofit corporation created in law.
