#### 1 AN ACT 2 To amend and reenact R.S. 37:45(A)(1) and (B), relative to the Occupational Licensing 3 Review Commission; to add additional members to the commission; to make 4 technical changes; and to provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 37:45 (A)(1) and (B) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as 7 follows: 8 §45. Occupational Licensing Review Commission 9 There is hereby created the Occupational Licensing Review A.(1) 10 Commission to be composed of the governor or his designee, the president of the 11 Senate or his designee, the speaker of the House of Representatives or his designee, 12 the secretary of state or his designee, the chair of the Senate Committee on 13 Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs or his designee, the chair 14 of the House Committee on Commerce or his designee, the commissioner of 15 agriculture or his designee, the commissioner of insurance or his designee, and the 16 state treasurer or his designee. The governor shall be the chairman of the 17 commission and the secretary of state shall be the secretary. The commission shall 18 meet as needed or as called by the chair and such meetings shall be subject to the 19 Open Meetings Law. A majority of the members constitutes a quorum at any 20 meeting. Any final action taken by the commission requires the affirmative vote of 21 a majority of the members. 22

1	B. Beginning January 1, 2019, the <u>The</u> commission is responsible for the
2	active supervision of state executive branch occupational licensing boards controlled
3	by active market participants to ensure compliance with state policy in the adoption
4	of occupational regulations promulgated by an occupational licensing board. The
5	required active supervision described in this Chapter does not extend to individual
6	disciplinary actions taken or imposed by an occupational licensing board as to any
7	active market participant subject to the jurisdiction of the occupational licensing
8	board.
