MUNICIPAL/LAWRASON ACT: Precludes individual from qualifying to run for mayor in certain circumstances

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:384, relative to qualifications of a candidate for mayor in a
3	municipality governed by a mayor-board of alderman form of government; to
4	prohibit a person who owes a debt that is past due to such a municipality from
5	qualifying as a candidate for mayor of the municipality; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 33:384 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§384. Qualifications of mayor
10	<u>A.</u> The mayor shall be an elector of the municipality who at the time of
11	qualification as a candidate for the office of mayor shall have has been domiciled and
12	actually resided for at least the immediately preceding year in the municipality.
13	B. No person who owes a debt that is past due to the municipality shall
14	qualify as a candidate for mayor of the municipality.

Abstract: Prohibits a person who owes a debt that is past due to the municipality from qualifying as a candidate for mayor.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 33:384) provides qualifications for mayor in a municipality governed by a mayor-board of alderman form of government. Provides that the mayor shall be an elector of the municipality who at the time of qualification as a candidate has been domiciled and actually resided for at least the immediately preceding year in the municipality. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally provides that no person who owes a debt that is past due to the municipality shall qualify as a candidate for mayor of the municipality.
