6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 30:2344(D) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 30:2344(E)
8	and (F) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§2344. Rules and regulations
10	* * *
11	D. Abatement activities shall be commenced as soon as rules and regulations
12	concerning abatement are approved by the commission provided for by this Chapter,
13	and finalized promulgated by the Department of Environmental Quality, in
14	accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.
15	E. The building owner shall select the method of abatement to be used from
16	those set forth in R.S. 30:2343(1) or as provided in the rules and regulations adopted
17	pursuant to this Chapter. Any method selected must be used in the manner that such
18	rules and regulations require.
19	F. No school, which has commenced abatement work at a particular site
20	prior to the effective date of regulations or standards adopted or imposed pursuant

to this Chapter, shall be required to conduct a different type of abatement at the same

site unless levels of airborne asbestos fibers exceed an abatement action level

established by the regulations adopted pursuant to this Chapter which are applicable

Morris HB No. 895

Abstract: Repeals the La. School Asbestos Abatement Commission and provides for methods of asbestos abatement.

<u>Present law</u> created the La. School Asbestos Abatement Commission to recommend to the secretary of the Dept. of Environmental Quality rules and regulations on asbestos abatement by Jan. 1, 1986.

Proposed law repeals present law.

<u>Present law</u>, (R.S. 30:2345(E)), requires building owners to select the method of abatement to be used from <u>present law</u> or as provided in rules and regulations in the manner that such rules and regulations require.

Proposed law redesignates present law.

<u>Present law</u>, (R.S. 30:2345(F)), provides that schools that have commenced abatement work prior to the effective date of regulations promulgated pursuant to <u>present law</u> shall not be required to conduct a different type of abatement unless levels of airborne asbestos fibers exceed an abatement action level.

Proposed law redesignates present law.
