EDUCATION/SPECIAL: Provides relative to funding procedures for special education

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1947(A), relative to funding for special educational services;
3	to provide procedures for the reimbursement of costs of education and related
4	services provided to certain students, including residents of residential and
5	intermediate care facilities; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:1947(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1947. Funding
9	A. Funding for public school special educational services as provided by
10	local education agencies shall be as follows:
11	(1) Each local education agency shall provide special education and related
12	services to students with exceptionalities who are located within its geographical
13	boundaries, including children who are placed in a private residential facility or an
14	intermediate care facility for the developmentally disabled for any reason by any
15	individual or agency; however, the agency shall pay the cost of such services only
16	for such students who are residents within the geographical boundaries of the
17	agency. Each local education agency shall provide child find and evaluation to
18	nonresident students who attend a parentally placed private elementary or secondary
19	school.
20	(2) If a local education agency provides special education and related
21	services to a student with an exceptionality who is located within the geographical
22	boundaries of such agency but is not a resident thereof, including children who are

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placed in a private residential facility or an intermediate care facility for the developmentally disabled for any reason by any individual or agency, the cost of any special education and related services shall be reimbursed by the local education agency within the boundaries of which the student resides, except as provided in Paragraph (3) of this Subsection.

(3) If a student with an exceptionality is living in a private residential facility in this state but the student is not a resident of this state, the local education agency providing any special education and related services to that student shall be reimbursed by the residential facility for the cost of providing those services.

Shadoin HB No. 915

Abstract: Provides relative to funding procedures for special education and relative services.

<u>Present law</u> provides for funding for public school special educational services as provided by local education agencies for students with exceptionalities as follows:

- (1) For a student located within a local education agency's geographic boundaries, including children in private residential facilities or intermediate care facilities for the developmentally disabled, the agency shall pay the cost of special education and related services only if the student is a resident within the agency's geographical boundaries.
- (2) For a student located within a local education agency's geographical boundaries who is not a resident thereof, including children in private residential facilities or intermediate care facilities for the developmentally disabled, the cost of special education and related services shall be reimbursed by the agency within the boundaries of which the student resides except if the student is living in a private residential facility but is not a La. resident, then the agency providing the special education and related services shall be reimbursed by the residential facility.

<u>Proposed law</u> deletes all references to "special" education services and students "with exceptionalities" and makes <u>present law</u> applicable to all education and related services for all students. Also deletes references to facilities "for the developmentally disabled".
