SCHOOLS/ADMINISTRATORS: Requires the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to adopt certain policies for waiver requirements for local public school systems relative to out-of-field authorizations for school administrators

AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 17:7(33), relative to the powers and duties of the State Board of Elementary
3	and Secondary Education; to require the board to develop and adopt certain policies
4	for waiver requirements provided to local public school systems relative to out-of-
5	field authorizations as it relates to school administrators; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 17:7(33) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§7. Duties, functions, and responsibilities of board
0	In addition to the authorities granted by R.S. 17:6 and any powers, duties, and
1	responsibilities vested by any other applicable laws, the board shall:

13	(33) Notwithstanding any policy, rule, or regulation to the contrary, develop
14	and adopt policies for waivers issued to city, parish, and other local public school
15	systems for out-of-field authorizations for school administrators upon verification
16	by the local school superintendent that there is no regularly certified, competent, and
17	suitable person available for a position. Such policies shall include the same
18	requirements and limitations as waivers issued to school systems for out-of-field
9	authorizations for teaching positions including but not limited to requirements and

limitations for renewal time lines. The policies also shall include requirements for

continual monitoring by the state Department of Education with regard to

compliance by school systems with proper advertisement and recruitment

requirements as may be provided through policy, rule, or regulation.

Hunter HB No. 925

Abstract: Requires BESE to develop and adopt certain policies for waiver requirements provided to local public school systems relative to out-of-field authorizations for school administrators' positions.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the powers and duties of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE).

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that BESE shall develop and adopt policies for waivers issued to local public school systems for out-of-field authorizations for school administrators upon certain verification by the local superintendent. Provides that the policies shall include the same requirements and limitations as waivers issued to school systems for out-of-field authorizations for teaching positions including requirements and limitations for renewal time lines. Further provides that the policies include requirements for continual monitoring by the state Dept. of Education regarding compliance by school systems with proper advertisement and recruitment requirements as may be provided through policy, rule, or regulation.
