HOUSE BILL NO. 936 (Substitute for House Bill No. 329 by Representative Marcelle)

BY REPRESENTATIVE MARCELLE

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 47:532.1(A)(5) and to enact R.S. 47:532.1(A)(7)(e), (f), and (g)
3 and (E), relative to public license tag agents; to provide relative to the fee assessed
4 for public license tag agents to require license plates be made available to public
5 license tag agents; to require for payment of production of such license plates and
6 reimbursement of such payment; to require public license tag agents undertake
7 certain actions; to provide relative to contracts between the Department of Public
8 Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles and public license tag agents; and
9 to provide for related matters.

10 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

11 Section 1. R.S. 47:532.1(A)(5) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
12 47:532.1(A)(7)(e), (f), and (g) and (E) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

13 §532.1. Public license tag agents; auto title companies; rules and regulations; surety
14 bonds; fees

17 (5) ~~An annual~~ A biennial fee may be assessed by the commissioner collected
18 from a person seeking to contract with the Department of Public Safety and
19 Correction, office of motor vehicles, prior to a person commencing to act as a public
20 license tag agent, provided that such fee does not exceed one hundred dollars two
21 hundred dollars and is adopted in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.

1 Section 2. A contract entered into between the Department of Public Safety and
 2 Corrections, office of motor vehicles, and a public license tag agent in 2016 but prior to the
 3 effective date of this Act shall be extended for one year without need for amendment of the
 4 contract upon payment by the public license tag agent of a one hundred dollar fee.

5 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
 6 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
 7 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
 8 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
 9 effective on the day following such approval.
