R.S. 17:170.4(C)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 8 Immunizations of certain persons against meningococcal disease; 9 exceptions 10 11 C. 12 13 (2) The secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals shall provide 14 such rules, including the implementation schedule, to the state Department of 15 Education by not later than August 1, 2009. The state Department of Education shall 16 notify each city, parish, or other local school board, and the governing authority of 17 each nonpublic school system or school in the case of a school not a part of a school 18 system, and the parent or legal guardian of any student participating in an approved 19 home study program as specified in Subparagraph (A)(1)(c) of this Section of the

Baldone HB No. 936

Abstract: Removes requirement that certain students in approved home study programs provide evidence of current immunization against meningococcal disease.

<u>Present law</u> requires 11-year-old students in approved home study programs to provide evidence of current immunization against meningococcal disease to BESE and requires the state Dept. of Ed. to notify such students' parents or legal guardians of such requirement. <u>Proposed law</u> removes <u>present law</u>.
