AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 17:7.1(B)(3)(introductory paragraph), relative to teacher certification; to provide relative to the employment experience necessary for certain principals to be exempt from certain testing requirements relative to certification; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 17:7.1(B)(3)(introductory paragraph) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§7.1. Certification of teachers; certification of principals and superintendents; certification of school psychologists

(3) Any principal who holds valid out-of-state certification as a principal, has at least four years of successful experience as a principal in another state as determined by the board, and has completed one year of successful employment as an assistant principal or a principal in a Louisiana public school system shall not be required to take the examination administered in accordance with the provisions of this Subsection or to submit any examination scores from any examination
