2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:2173(A), (B)(7), (E), and (F), 2844(B)(introductory
3	paragraph) and (1), (C)(1) and (2), 2845(A)(1) and (D), and R.S. 44:4.1(B)(24) and
4	to enact R.S. 40:2173(B)(8) and (9), 2844(B)(21), (22), (23), and (24), 2845(A)(6)
5	and (7), (E), and (F), and 2845.1, relative to the Louisiana Emergency Response
6	Network; to provide for requirements for trauma centers; to provide for membership
7	of the LERN board; to provide for powers and functions of the LERN board; to
8	provide for a statewide trauma registry; to provide for confidentiality requirements
9	for the statewide trauma registry; to provide authority to develop stroke and STEMI
10	systems; to create a LERN fund; to provide authority for publishing materials; to
11	provide for public records exceptions; and to provide for related matters.
12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
13	Section 1. R.S. 40:2173(A), (B)(7), (E), and (F), 2844(B)(introductory paragraph)
14	and $(1)$ , $(C)(1)$ and $(2)$ , and $2845(A)(1)$ and $(D)$ , are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
15	40:2173(B)(8) and (9), 2844(B)(21), (22), (23), and (24), 2845(A)(6) and (7), (E), and (F),
16	and 2845.1 are hereby enacted to read as follows:
17	§2173. Rules, regulations, and standards for licenses
18	A. The department shall promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the
19	provisions of this Part in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative
20	Procedure Act. The department shall consult with the Louisiana Emergency

1	Response Network (LERN), the Louisiana Hospital Association, and the Louisiana
2	State Medical Society in the development of rules and regulations.
3	B. The department shall promulgate minimum standards for trauma centers
4	as defined in this Part which shall:
5	* * *
6	(7) Provide for the establishment in the state of a central data reporting and
7	analysis system to:
8	(a) Identify severely injured trauma patients at all health care facilities in the
9	state.
10	(b) Identify the total amount of uncompensated trauma care expenditures
11	made for each fiscal year by each health care facility in the state.
12	(c) Monitor trauma patient care in each certified trauma center in the state.
13	Provide for the verification and certification of trauma center status which
14	assign level designations based on resources available within the applicable facility.
15	Rules shall be based upon national guidelines, including but not limited to those
16	established by the American College of Surgeons in Hospital and Pre-Hospital
17	Resources for Optimal Care of the Injured Patient and any published appendices
18	thereto.
19	(8) Provide that LERN may fund the provision of data to the state trauma
20	registry in accordance with the registry's adopted rules, requirements, and reporting
21	cycle.
22	(9) Provide that certified trauma centers participate in LERN regional
23	commissions and LERN regional and state-level trauma system performance
24	improvement and injury prevention activities per American College of Surgeons
25	guidelines once adequate funding has been secured by the certified trauma center.

27	E. The department shall designate a health care facility as a primary trauma
28	center when the requirements of this Section have been fulfilled and upon
29	verification from the American College of Surgeons that the facility has met its
30	criteria for Level I, or III, or III. A facility which meets the criteria for Level III and

1	the requirements of this Section shall be certified as a secondary trauma center. The
2	"trauma center" label shall be reserved exclusively for hospitals with state-issued
3	trauma center certification.
4	F. The department shall promulgate issue standard forms for applications and
5	for inspection reports, after consultation with LERN and other appropriate
6	organizations.

11	B. The network shall be governed by a board of twenty-four twenty-eight
12	members which shall include:
13	(1) One member cardiologist from nominees submitted by the Louisiana
14	Ambulance Association Chapter of the American College of Cardiology.
15	* * *
16	(21) One physician from nominees submitted by the American Stroke
17	Association.
18	(22) One registered nurse practicing in emergency or critical care from
19	nominees submitted by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing.
20	(23) One medical director of an emergency medical services agency from
21	nominees submitted by the Louisiana Association of EMS Physicians.
22	(24) One optometrist from nominees submitted by the Optometry
23	Association of Louisiana.
24	C.(1) The members listed in Paragraphs (B)(1) through (14) and (17) through
25	(20)(24) of this Section shall be appointed by the governor from a list of qualified
26	candidates nominated by the respective organizations.
27	(2) The organizations listed in Paragraphs (B)(1) through (14) and (17)
28	through $\frac{(20)(24)}{(20)}$ of this Section shall each submit a list of $\frac{1}{20}$ least four nominees
29	for the respective board position to the governor.

A.	The	board	shall:

(1) Provide for the development, implementation, and support of a statewide system that provides access to care in a seamless, coordinated manner for trauma and time-sensitive injured patients based upon the participation of public and private pre-hospital, acute care, post-acute care, and rehabilitation programs located throughout Louisiana. Establish and maintain a statewide trauma system that shall include a centralized communication center for resource coordination of medical capabilities for participating trauma centers as defined by R.S. 40:2171 and emergency medical services.

\* \* \*

- (6) Establish and maintain a statewide trauma registry to collect and analyze data on the incidence, severity, and causes of trauma, including traumatic brain injury. The registry shall be used to improve the availability and delivery of prehospital or out-of-hospital care and hospital trauma care services.
- (a) The board shall promulgate rules and regulations according to the Administrative Procedure Act to do the following:
- (i) Define specific data elements required to be furnished to the registry by every health care facility certified by the department as a trauma center.
- (ii) Define trauma data elements that all other health care facilities shall be required to furnish to the registry.
- (iii) Establish a process for submission, analysis, and reporting of registry data.
- (b) Required reporting to the state trauma registry is contingent on LERN providing adequate financial support through the Louisiana Emergency Response Network fund to cover administrative costs.
- (7) Work with the department to develop stroke and ST segment elevation myocardial infarction (STEMI) systems that are designed to promote rapid identification of, and access to, appropriate stroke and STEMI resources statewide.

1	D.(1) The board may accept grants, donations, or gifts of money of services
2	from public or private organizations or from any other sources to be utilized for the
3	purposes of the board.
4	(2) There is hereby created in the state treasury, a special fund called the
5	Louisiana Emergency Response Network Fund. The source of monies deposited into
6	the fund may be any monies appropriated annually by the legislature, including
7	federal funds, any public or private donations, gifts, or grants from individuals,
8	corporations, nonprofit organizations, or other business entities which may be made
9	to the fund, and any other monies which may be provided by law.
10	(3) Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the
11	state general fund, and interest earned on investment of monies in the fund shall be
12	credited to the state general fund. Unexpended and unencumbered monies in the
13	fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund.
14	E. Subject to any appropriation by the legislature, monies in the fund shall
15	be used as directed by the board solely to fund grants, projects, and services which
16	will address the goals and objectives of the board as authorized in this Chapter.
17	F. In addition to annual reports to the legislature, the board may publish
18	documents and materials intended to further the mission or purpose of the board.

20	Patient and peer review data or information submitted or transmitted pursuant
21	to this Chapter to the trauma registry, the board, any committee acting on behalf of
22	the board, any hospital or pre-hospital care provider, any physician or other direct

24	emergency medical services agency, or other group or committee whose purpose is
25	to monitor and improve quality care pursuant to this Chapter, shall be confidential
