A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To designate the town of Welsh as the Home of the Cajun Dictionary.

WHEREAS, for over twenty years, Monsignor Jules O. Daigle served as pastor of

Our Lady of Seven Dolors Church with great passion and devotion; and

WHEREAS, Father Daigle was an idol for the Cajuns, and he worked to preserve

their faith and the Cajun French language; and

WHEREAS, in 1984, after his retirement from the priesthood, he published a

Dictionary of the Cajun Language, which was the first dictionary devoted to Cajun French;

and

WHEREAS, Father Daigle's Dictionary of the Cajun Language will forever be an

integral part of the town of Welsh.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby

designate the town of Welsh as the Home of the Cajun Dictionary.
