

1 WHEREAS, for local school boards located in smaller parishes, the cost of
2 termination based on current assessments may be cost-prohibitive, leaving the local school
3 boards with no option but to remain in the program.

4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
5 urge and request the Office of Group Benefits to study the cost for each member school
6 board to terminate its participation in the programs offered through the Office of Group
7 Benefits.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Group Benefits shall submit a
9 written report of its findings to the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate
10 Committee on Finance not later than sixty days prior to the beginning of the 2016 Regular
11 Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
13 to the chief executive officer of the Office of Group Benefits and the commissioner of
14 administration.
