HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 129

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request Jefferson Parish to study the feasibility of adding a surcharge to the state motor vehicle inspection fee to fund transportation infrastructure and request the legislative delegation to enact legislation to authorize adding such surcharge to the state motor vehicle inspection fee in Jefferson Parish.

WHEREAS, there are many motor vehicle inspection stations throughout the state of Louisiana for citizens to get their vehicles inspected; and

WHEREAS, every person residing in the parish owning a vehicle operated upon the streets of the parish shall have their vehicle inspected once in a twelve-month period; and

WHEREAS, public transportation in the United States is a crucial part of the solution to the nation's economic, energy, and environmental challenges, helping to bring better quality of life; and

WHEREAS, due to the rising costs of transportation, the surcharge on inspections will be feasible to fund transportation infrastructure.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request Jefferson Parish to study the feasibility of adding a surcharge to the state motor vehicle inspection fee to fund transportation infrastructure and request the legislative delegation to enact legislation to authorize adding such surcharge to the state motor vehicle inspection fee in Jefferson Parish.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Jefferson Parish governing authority.
