A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend the Main Street of New Iberia, Louisiana, upon receipt of a 2013 Louisiana Culture Award.

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2013, Louisiana Lieutenant Governor Jay Dardenne and the Louisiana Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism's office of cultural development partnered with the Louisiana Arts Council, the Louisiana Trust for Historic Preservation, and the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana to present the 2013 Louisiana Culture Awards; and

WHEREAS, the city of New Iberia's achievements in downtown revitalization exemplify the Main Street approach; and

WHEREAS, private investors and community volunteers alike have worked side-byside to create the Main Street that residents of New Iberia, Louisiana, enjoy today; and

WHEREAS, the award-winning, best-selling Louisiana author James Lee Burke has described New Iberia's Main Street as "one of the most beautiful main streets in the country"; and

WHEREAS, the Main Street of New Iberia was an excellent candidate to win the highly esteemed Main Street Award, presented by Lieutenant Governor Jay Dardenne at the 2013 Louisiana Culture Awards ceremony.
