1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To recognize Saturday, May 4, 2013, as Lemonade Day Louisiana.
3	WHEREAS, Lemonade Day Louisiana is a free, community-wide program that
4	fosters entrepreneurship and character development among Louisiana's youth by supporting
5	them in establishing and operating their own lemonade businesses; and
6	WHEREAS, Lemonade Day Louisiana was founded in 2010 by John Georges and
7	Todd Graves and has grown tremendously over the last few years; and
8	WHEREAS, over ten thousand youth across south Louisiana from New Orleans to
9	Lafayette participated in last year's Lemonade Day Louisiana; and
10	WHEREAS, on Saturday, May 4, 2013, thousands of lemonade stands will be set up
11	throughout the state, and the young entrepreneurs are encouraged to donate a portion of their
12	proceeds to charity; and

14	a lasting impact on the more than thirteen thousand youth across Louisiana who will
15	participate; and
16	WHEREAS, citizens around the state are encouraged to purchase lemonade from the
17	many stands that will be set up; and

19	companies throughout the state, including Raising Canes, Chevron, Liberty Bank, Century
20	Link, and United Healthcare; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana is one of over forty regions in the United States and Canada
