A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To designate Saturday, March 23, 2024, as Moon Pie Festival Day at the state capitol.

Moon Pies and drinking RC Cola is a Southern tradition; and

WHEREAS, the town of Ball is planning to host its first festival, the Moon Pie

Festival, on March 23, 2024; and

WHEREAS, visitors to the Moon Pie Festival will be able to listen to songs such as

"Gimme a RC Cola and a Moon Pie" by Big Bill Lister, "Lifestyles of the Not So Rich and

WHEREAS, Chattanooga Bakery in Chattanooga, Tennessee are the makers of the

Moon Pie, and the bakery has given its approval of the Moon Pie festival; the festival will

photos, a Moon Pie eating contest, and various children's activities.
