COMMENDATIONS: Commends 2010 International Legislative Drafting Institute participants and welcomes them to the state capitol

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To commend the 2010 International Legislative Drafting Institute participants and to
3 welcome them to the Louisiana State Capitol.

4 WHEREAS, the Public Law Center, a joint venture of the Loyola and Tulane law
5 schools, launched the International Legislative Drafting Institute in 1995 in response to
6 increasing global demand for training of legislative drafters; and

7 WHEREAS, the Institute is a two-week summer program that responds to the
8 worldwide demand on legislative drafters for new laws to support the emergence of free
9 market economies and democratic forms of government and draws together diverse domestic
10 and international faculty members experienced in the legislative process; and

11 WHEREAS, approximately five hundred participants from more than eighty-five
12 countries around the globe have graduated from the institute, and staff members of the
13 Public Law Center have conducted training events in Europe, Asia, Africa, and the
14 Caribbean; and

15 WHEREAS, except for 2006 and 2007, each year, Institute participants have traveled
16 to Baton Rouge to spend a day at the Louisiana State Capitol, where they get a firsthand look
17 at representative democracy; and

18 WHEREAS, staff members of the Louisiana Legislature have a long tradition of
19 assisting with the training of institute participants, both in the classroom and during their site
20 visit to Baton Rouge; and

1 WHEREAS, the 2010 class is visiting the state capitol on Wednesday, June twenty-
2 third; and

3 WHEREAS, the legislature recognizes the critical importance of the International
4 Legislative Drafting Institute and the lessons it imparts, the tremendous achievement of the
5 individual students in being selected by their home jurisdictions to participate, and the hard
6 work that the institute requires of its participants, who merit a special measure of
7 commendation.

8 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
9 commend the 2010 International Legislative Drafting Institute participants and the
10 jurisdictions they represent for their investment of time, effort, and resources in the
11 improvement of their governments in general and of legislative drafting in particular and
12 does hereby welcome them with great pride and honor to the Louisiana State Capitol.
