4 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to commend Alexie D. Gaddis upon her receipt of a  
5 2011 Women of Excellence Award from the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus  
6 Foundation and to recognize her vital contributions to the citizens of Louisiana as an active  
7 and dedicated community servant; and

8 WHEREAS, Alexie D. Gaddis attends Loyola University in New Orleans, where she  
9 is currently an honors student and junior majoring in both psychology and Spanish; she is  
10 a member of the Phi Eta Sigma Freshman Society and the Psi Chi Psychology Society and  
11 vice president of the Sigma Delta Pi Spanish Honor Society, and she recently was extended  
12 an invitation to the Sigma Alpha Nu Jesuit Honor Society; she is also a member of the Nu  
13 Mu Citywide Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, the Genesis Gospel  
14 Choir, the leadSTRONG Committee, and the Ignacio Volunteers, and she is the president  
15 of the Black Student Union; and

16 WHEREAS, Ms. Gaddis recently was selected as a Krewe Leader for the incoming  
17 freshman class of 2015 as well as appointed to serve as chair of the "Issues N' Outreach"  
18 Committee for the University Programming Board; she is an intern with the Multicultural

1 Programs in the Office of Co-Curricular, a psychology research assistant, and a student  
2 representative for the psychology department; and

3 WHEREAS, Ms. Gaddis was awarded the Martin Luther King, Jr. Community  
4 Service Award; she organizes bimonthly service trips to tutor elementary students; and she  
5 has also organized a campus-wide Christmas toy drive for a state agency serving abused and  
6 neglected children in state custody; she was voted most influential student on campus in the  
7 school's magazine; and

8 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation created the  
9 Women of Excellence Awards to recognize and honor extraordinary women of excellence  
10 across the state for their outstanding achievements and contributions; and

11 WHEREAS, recipients of the Women of Excellence Awards exhibit characteristics  
12 of integrity and professionalism, personify excellence in their area of specialty, and are  
13 committed to community service to better society as a whole; and

14 WHEREAS, this year, there were seven categories for the Women of Excellence  
15 Awards: Business, College Woman of Excellence, Education, Health and Medicine, High  
16 School Woman of Excellence, Media and Public Relations, and Volunteerism and Civic  
17 Involvement; and

18 WHEREAS, the recipients of the 2011 Women of Excellence Awards are being  
19 recognized at the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation's Women of  
20 Excellence Awards Gala on Wednesday, May 11, 2011, in Baton Rouge; and

21 WHEREAS, Alexie D. Gaddis received a 2011 Women of Excellence Award in the  
22 category of College Woman of Excellence for her highly productive community activism  
23 and service; and

24 WHEREAS, Alexie D. Gaddis merits a sincere and heartfelt measure of  
25 commendation for her dedication to excellence and her outstanding accomplishments.
