

1 WHEREAS, in order to provide efficient reporting, it is necessary that the data
2 collection be suspended; and

3 WHEREAS, the suspension of R.S. 13:4688 also provides for the suspension of the
4 processing fee allocated to the clerk of court and the taxable costs allocated to the office of
5 the judicial administrator which reduces civil filing fees.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby suspends
7 the provisions of R.S. 13:4688 relative to reporting information concerning actions for
8 offenses and quasi offenses.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this suspension shall become effective upon
10 adoption of this Resolution and shall extend through August 1, 2024.
