# BUDGETARY PROCEDURES: Provides for the expenditure limit for Fiscal Year 2021-2022

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To direct the commissioner of administration to change the expenditure limit for Fiscal Year
3	2021-2022.
4	WHEREAS, the expenditure limit provided for in Article VII, Section 10(C)(1) of
5	the Constitution of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 is established as Fifteen Billion
6	Twenty-One Million Six Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Thirty-Five and No/100
7	(\$15,021,678,035.00) Dollars; and
8	WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10(C)(2) of the Constitution of Louisiana provides
9	that the expenditure limit may be changed in any fiscal year by a favorable vote of two-thirds
10	of the elected members of each house and that any such change in the expenditure limit shall
11	be approved by the passage of a specific legislative instrument which clearly states the intent
12	to change the limit; and
13	WHEREAS, R.S. 39:52.1 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 provides that
14	a change to the expenditure limit shall be made pursuant to a concurrent resolution adopted
15	by a favorable vote of two-thirds of the elected members of each house directing the
16	commissioner of administration to change the expenditure limit to a designated amount for
17	a specified fiscal year.
18	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of
19	the elected members of each house concurring, does hereby direct the commissioner of
20	administration to increase the expenditure limit for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 by the amount
21	of One Million and No/100 (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars and to change the expenditure limit for

- 1 Fiscal Year 2021-2022 to Fifteen Billion Twenty-Two Million Six Hundred Seventy-Eight
- 2 Thousand Thirty-Five and No/100 (\$15,022,678,035.00) Dollars.
