

1 legislators have expressed their belief in the importance of some of these requirements and
2 their desire for BESE to prioritize them in its rulemaking process, particularly as they pertain
3 to suicide prevention and mental health.

4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
5 authorize and direct the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to prioritize
6 policies pertaining to organ donation education in its rulemaking process as authorized by
7 House Bill No. 320 of this 2024 Regular Session should that bill become law.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state board shall provide ample opportunity
9 for input from concerned citizens and advocacy groups in the rule promulgation process.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
11 president of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the state
12 superintendent of education.
