2 To commend the Lafayette High School (LHS) girls' soccer team upon the completion of a  
3 sensational 2012-2013 season and to congratulate the players and coaches for  
4 winning the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) Division I state  
5 soccer championship.

6 WHEREAS, after a highly successful regular season, the LHS Mighty Lions defeated  
7 the St. Scholastica Doves by a score of 2-1 in the Division I state soccer championship  
8 match at Tad Gormley Stadium in New Orleans, Louisiana; and

10 determination allowed the team to reach their goal of becoming champions; and

11 WHEREAS, LHS senior Larae Breaux was named Most Valuable Player of the
