



1           WHEREAS, it is also necessary to study the territorial boundaries and the  
2 jurisdictional limits of each court.

3           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
4 urge and request the supreme court to provide information concerning the caseload data and  
5 the number of judges of each appellate court and district court in Louisiana, the  
6 determination of the changes necessary to the existing structure of the judiciary and the most  
7 efficient use of judicial resources, and to report its findings and recommendations to the  
8 Louisiana Legislature no later than February 1, 2023.

9           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that one print copy and one electronic copy of any  
10 report produced pursuant to this Resolution shall be submitted to the David R. Poynter  
11 Legislative Research Library as required by R.S. 24:772.

12           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
13 supreme court.
