A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To recognize the week of May 6 through 12, 2016, as National Nurses Week in Louisiana.

WHEREAS, nearly thirty-four thousand registered nurses are professionally active in Louisiana and over three million one hundred twenty thousand registered nurses practice in the United States, making nursing our state's and the nation's largest healthcare profession; and

WHEREAS, the depth and breadth of the registered nursing profession meets the various established and emerging healthcare needs of the American population in a wide range of settings; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana State Nurses Association, as the voice for the registered nurses of this state, is working to chart a new course for a healthy Louisiana that relies on increasing delivery of primary and preventive health care; and

WHEREAS, the demand for registered nursing services is greater than ever due to the aging of the American population, the continuing expansion of life-sustaining technology, and the rapid pace of growth in home healthcare services; and

WHEREAS, more qualified registered nurses will be needed in the future to meet the increasingly complex needs of healthcare consumers in all communities of our state; and

WHEREAS, the safe, cost-effective healthcare services provided by registered nurses are consistently of the highest quality, and will be an ever more important component of the United States healthcare delivery system in the future; and

WHEREAS, since 1991, National Nurses Week has been celebrated annually from May 6, also known as National Recognition Day for Nurses, through May 12, the birthday of the founder of modern nursing, Florence Nightingale; and

nurses strive to provide safe and high-quality patient care and lead the way to improvements

in our healthcare system.
