1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To commend the members of the United States Army War College participating in the  
3 Eisenhower Series College Program and to welcome them to Louisiana in April of  
4 2013.

5 WHEREAS, upon the memorable and historic occasion of their visit to the state of  
6 Louisiana, it is appropriate to commend and honor those from the United States Army War  
7 College participating in the Eisenhower Series College Program; and

8 WHEREAS, the United States Army War College, located in Carlisle Barracks,  
9 Pennsylvania, represents the highest level of education offered by the military services and  
10 is designed to equip carefully selected senior officers and civilians with the competencies  
11 required of strategic leaders of the United States Armed Forces; and

12 WHEREAS, approximately three hundred sixty students, including senior officers  
13 from all branches of the armed forces, senior civilian representatives from a variety of  
14 United States government agencies, and senior military officers from sixty-six foreign  
15 countries, attend a ten-month graduate-level course of study; and

16 WHEREAS, United States Army War College students examine national security  
17 issues and strategy development, regional affairs, current and future challenges for national  
18 defense, and the responsibilities of senior-level command, and students who successfully  
19 complete all the requirements established by the Army War College for granting a degree  
20 are awarded the Master of Strategic Studies degree; and

1           WHEREAS, annually, several students at the United States Army War College  
2 participate in the Eisenhower Series College Program and travel outside Carlisle Barracks  
3 to engage in discussions with other students, academics, and the public about national  
4 security issues and the employment of military assets; and

5           WHEREAS, in April of 2013, Eisenhower Series College Program participants are  
6 sharing their unique knowledge with the citizens of Louisiana and visiting various education  
7 institutions, including Southeastern Louisiana University and the Louisiana State University  
8 Paul M. Hebert Law Center; and

9           WHEREAS, the actions and commitment of these individuals uphold the highest  
10 traditions of the United States Armed Forces, and they bring tremendous pride to their  
11 families, their fellow citizens, and the United States of America; and

12           WHEREAS, these individuals merit a special measure of commendation as they are  
13 welcomed with the utmost admiration and respect to the state of Louisiana.

14           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
15 commend the members of the United States Army War College who are participating in the  
16 Eisenhower Series College Program for their outstanding accomplishments, does hereby  
17 recognize and record for posterity their vital contributions and their tireless dedication to  
18 military excellence, does hereby express enduring appreciation for the tremendous honor  
19 they bring to the citizens of Louisiana with their visit in April of 2013, does hereby sincerely  
20 welcome them to Louisiana, and does hereby extend to them best wishes for continued  
21 success in all of their future endeavors.
