2	To authorize and direct state and local law enforcement agencies that own firing ranges to
3	provide Louisiana domiciled firearm manufacturers open access to such facilities.
4	WHEREAS, given the nature of firearms, ammunition, and related products, it is of
5	the utmost importance to the public health and safety that these items be designed and
6	manufactured to the very highest quality standards so that the product itself does not cause
7	damage or injury through product failure; and
8	WHEREAS, Louisiana domiciled manufacturers of firearms, ammunition, and
9	related products understand the importance of diligence in their design and manufacturing
0	work with such products; and
1	WHEREAS, notwithstanding excellence in every facet of development and
12	manufacture, the testing of new products is an absolutely critical component of the overall
13	process if the public health and safety is to be protected to the greatest extent possible; and
14	WHEREAS, state and local law enforcement agencies often operate firing ranges and
15	similar facilities which would be very suitable for testing new firearms, ammunition, and
16	related products, and it is in the best interest of the people of the state that such facilities
17	should be available to manufacturers for product testing.
18	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
19	authorize and direct state and local law enforcement agencies that own firing ranges to
20	provide Louisiana domiciled firearm manufacturers open access to such facilities.
