A RESOLUTION

To designate May 30, 2012, as 4-H Day at the legislature and to commend the state 4-H Executive Board officers, 4-H members, and volunteers throughout the state for their outstanding accomplishments.

WHEREAS, the LSU AgCenter 4-H program can trace its roots back to the "Corn Club", which began in Avoyelles Parish in 1908; and

WHEREAS, "Learning by Doing" is the 4-H club slogan which encourages members to develop and improve their critical thinking and communication skills; and

WHEREAS, today more than twelve hundred 4-H members and volunteers from all sixty-four parishes are at the capitol for the eleventh annual 4-H Day meeting with legislators and learning about the legislative process.
