2	To commend Louisiana State University at Shreveport for its record-breaking enrollment.
3	WHEREAS, Louisiana State University at Shreveport smashed its previous
4	enrollment record with a final spring 2024 enrollment of 10,214; LSU at Shreveport
5	increased its enrollment by nearly 1,500 students over Spring 2023, a jump of 17%
6	year-over-year; and
7	WHEREAS, LSU at Shreveport crossed the ten thousand student threshold for the
8	first time in the university's history, thanks to increases in both undergraduate and graduate
9	enrollments and in both online and face-to-face programs; and
10	WHEREAS, LSU at Shreveport has developed programs that are meeting student
11	interests as well as contemporary workforce needs; and
12	WHEREAS, LSU at Shreveport's growth comes at a time when many universities
13	in the state and across the nation are navigating enrollment and financial headwinds; and
14	WHEREAS, LSU at Shreveport's graduate enrollment set a record with 7,756
15	students, representing the highest graduate student enrollment in the state.
16	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
17	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Louisiana State University at Shreveport for
18	its record-breaking enrollment and does hereby extend sincerest wishes that the university
19	and its students continue their excellent work and always strive for greatness.
