COMMENDATIONS: Commends Baton Rouge police officer Corporal Billy Aime for his service

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend police officer Corporal Billy Aime for his service.

3 WHEREAS, the life of a police officer is fraught with danger, and each day brings
4 the possibility of personal hazard; yet, faithful men and women in uniform continue to labor
5 to bring safety and stability to the citizenry they have vowed to protect and serve; and

6 WHEREAS, on Sunday, February 19, 2017, Corporal Billy Alan Aime of the Baton
7 Rouge Police Department was forced to engage a suspect who became violent; and

8 WHEREAS, good officers know that the police and citizens must work together, and
9 were it not for the aid of Vickie Williams-Tillman, a citizen passerby, Corporal Aime may
10 have suffered great harm; and

11 WHEREAS, Corporal Aime has twenty-one years of experience in police work and
12 has served nine years in the Baton Rouge Police Department; he is grateful for the
13 intervention of Ms. Williams-Tillman, who he called "a true hero"; and

14 WHEREAS, the citizens of Baton Rouge and the state entrust their security to
15 officers like Corporal Aime, and it is fitting to herald his diligence in the execution of his
16 duty.

17 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
18 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Corporal Billy Aime for his service to the
19 citizens of Baton Rouge and does hereby express sincerest hope for many years of safety in
20 every aspect of police work for Corporal Aime and his fellow officers.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
2 to Corporal Billy Aime.
