1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Gerald Paul
3 Doiron, Sr., of Houma.

4 WHEREAS, it is with deep regret and profound sorrow that members of the
5 Louisiana House of Representatives have learned of the death of Gerald Paul Doiron, Sr.,
6 on Friday, May 31, 2013, at the age of seventy-nine; and

7 WHEREAS, Gerald Paul Doiron, Sr., was born to the late Clayton and Marguerite
8 Doiron in Houma, Louisiana, on July 15, 1933, and was the oldest boy of eight children; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron attended St. Francis de Sales School and graduated in 1951,
10 he was on the first football team at the school, was crowned homecoming king, and was the
11 first recipient of the Bishop Schexnayder Award; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron served his country honorably in the United States Army for
13 many years; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron was a man of passion and diligence who went to electronic
15 trade school after leaving the military, and was the owner of Doiron's T.V. Sales & Service
16 for fifty years. He was known as the "TV" man among many in Houma and was assisted in
17 the business by his son, Jerry, who will never forget all of the knowledge and wisdom his
18 greatest mentor, his father, gave him; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron was a devout Catholic and parishioner of Maria Immacolata
20 Catholic Church; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron was married to his beloved wife, Kathleen Griffin, for
2 thirty-nine years; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron was a devoted father to Becky Blanchard, Brenda Doiron,
4 Gerald "Jerry" Doiron, Jr., Beth McNamara, Bridget Lusco, and Amanda Falgoust; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron was a wonderful grandfather to Danielle Doiron Leger,
6 Brandon McNamara, Brent McNamara, Lauren Lusco, Tyler Lusco, Katelyn Falgoust, and
7 Carter Falgoust, and great-grandfather to Braxton McNamara; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron enjoyed fishing, playing drums and piano, and spending
9 time with his family; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron was the rock of his family, and was known by "daddy",
11 "pawpaw" and "Bruh-man"; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Doiron's family is thankful for the many wonderful memories
13 shared while fishing with him, the Tuesday family suppers, the Doiron Christmas parties
14 where he played drums and sang Christmas carols, the many fishing trips at the camp, and
15 many more memories that will be cherished for the rest of their days; and

16 WHEREAS, although his death has left a tremendous void in his community and
17 family, Mr. Doiron's memory shall live on forever in the minds and hearts of all who were
18 fortunate enough to have known and loved him.

19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
20 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby extend sincere regrets and condolences to the family
21 of Gerald Paul Doiron, Sr., of Houma on the occasion of his death, and does hereby
22 acknowledge with gratitude his outstanding service, many accomplishments, and
