1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Dr. Gwenn Jackson, M.D., for her election as president of Quota International.

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Gwenn Jackson earned her medical degree from Louisiana State
4 University in New Orleans and has been a practicing physician specializing in obstetrics and
5 gynecology for the last twenty-five years; and

6 WHEREAS, a board certified Fellow of the American College of Obstetrics and
7 Gynecology, Dr. Jackson is a partner at the largest single-specialty clinic in Northeast
8 Louisiana, Woman's Clinic of Monroe, and served as chief of staff of Glenwood Regional
9 Medical Center from 2000-2001; and

10 WHEREAS, Quota International, founded in 1919, is an international service
11 organization that links 6,500 members of all ages, occupations, and nationalities in a
12 worldwide network which includes 285 clubs working in fourteen countries across the globe
13 with a motto of "We Share,"; and

14 WHEREAS, Quotarians are known especially for their service to deaf, hearing-
15 impaired, speech-impaired individuals, and disadvantaged women and children; and

16 WHEREAS, Quotarians share the values of serving and encouraging others,
17 developing friendships, and promoting international understanding; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Jackson joined Quota International of Monroe in 1989 and became
19 secretary/treasurer of District 21 in 2000, club president in 2001, and later became lieutenant
20 governor, and then governor of District 21; and

1 WHEREAS, as a member of Quota International, Dr. Jackson has served in
2 numerous capacities including membership of the International Convention Credentials
3 Committee and the International World Service Committee, as well as serving as South Area
4 director and as international treasurer; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Jackson is currently serving as president elect of Quota International
6 and will be installed as president on July 5, 2010, in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, in addition to her professional accomplishments, Dr. Jackson is an
9 active participant in her community as a member of First Baptist Church of West Monroe,
10 where she plays in the orchestra and serves on the medical and music missions teams; and

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Jackson has been married to her husband, Charles, for twenty-two
12 years, and the couple has two children, Chas and Sarah.

13 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
14 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Dr. Gwenn Jackson on her outstanding
15 accomplishments and service to her community, the state of Louisiana, and the world
16 through her leadership, initiative, and election as president of Quota International.
