A RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development to place a dedicated

left turn traffic control signal in the north bound lane on Essen Lane at its

intersection with Essen Park Avenue near the LSU Rural Life Museum.

WHEREAS, dedicated left turn traffic control signals are designed to enhance

highway safety, facilitate orderly movement of traffic, and reduce traffic delays and

accidents; and

WHEREAS, Essen Lane is a heavily traveled area, with the LSU Rural Life Museum

located near the interstate, and a directional traffic control signal may allow those working

at or visiting the museum easier and safer access as well as alleviate traffic congestion.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby

urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development, in consultation with

the local governing authority, to erect a dedicated left turn traffic control signal in the north

bound lane on Essen Lane at its intersection with Essen Park Avenue near the LSU Rural

Life Museum.
