1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Wilmon  
3 "Butch" Little of French Settlement.

4 WHEREAS, it was with great sadness of hearts that members of the House of  
5 Representatives received word that Wilmon "Butch" Little transitioned from this realm to  
6 eternity on Friday, May 26, 2017, at the age of seventy-five; and

7 WHEREAS, a son of Arthur and Marie Aline Little, Wilmon was one of four boys  
8 born to the couple; his brother Arthur Little, Jr., and his parents preceded him in death; and

9 WHEREAS, Butch Little married his sweetheart, Diane, and they were blessed with  
10 four children; his son, Wilmon Little, Jr., and his wife preceded him in death; and

11 WHEREAS, well known for his athletic abilities and his love of coaching and  
12 teaching youth, Butch Little earned a master's degree in administration and was employed  
13 with the Ascension Parish, St. James Parish, and Livingston Parish school systems; he was  
14 vice principal and principal at East Ascension High School, and he coached sports in each  
15 school system for which he worked; and

16 WHEREAS, Butch enjoyed sharing tips on basketball and watching games with his  
17 family of sports enthusiasts and spent hours entertaining his children, nephews, and nieces;  
18 six years ago, Butch Little opened another chapter in the book of his life when he married  
19 Patricia Montgomery Little, "his Tricia"; and

1           WHEREAS, left behind to cherish his memory are his wife, Patricia; his children,  
2 Nicole DeSouge, and her husband Clint, Jeff Little, and his wife Rose, and Greg Little; his  
3 brothers, James Little, and his wife Elaine, and Curtis Little; his grandchildren, Colby Little,  
4 and his wife Jaime, Catherine Little, and her fiancé Ethan Guidry; Caroline and Brennan  
5 Little, Jordan, Cameron, and Cade DeSouge; and his great-granddaughter, Riley Ann Little;

7           WHEREAS, Butch was a man full of *la joie de vivre*; he loved his family deeply, and  
8 he was proud of the positive impact he made on the lives of students throughout his coaching  
9 and administrative career in education; Louisiana has lost one of her finest sons with the
