COMMENDATIONS: Expresses support for the work of the Louisiana office of soil and water conservation in the Department of Agriculture and Forestry

A RESOLUTION

2	To express support for the work of the Louisiana office of soil and water conservation in the
3	Department of Agriculture and Forestry.
4	WHEREAS, the office of soil and water conservation is a major division of the
5	Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry; and
6	WHEREAS, the critically important role of the office of soil and water conservation
7	extends back to the creation of the State Soil and Water Conservation Commission by the
8	Legislature of Louisiana in 1938 under Act No. 370, which established the Louisiana
9	Conservation District Program, whose operation has continued through revisions in 1956 and
10	1985; and
11	WHEREAS, this role includes collaboration and support for forty-four soil and water
12	conservation districts, which function as unique local units of government to provide
13	conservation services for landowners across the state and work in cooperation with
14	producers and other partner agencies; and
15	WHEREAS, the Louisiana office of soil and water conservation also carries out and
16	collaborates with numerous partners on projects that promote education, outreach, and
17	innovation for agricultural, wetland, and urban conservation and management; and
18	WHEREAS, since its creation, the Louisiana office of soil and water conservation
19	has also worked in collaboration with the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Natural
20	Resources Conservation Service to carry out programs and projects under the Soil
21	Conservation and Domestic Allotment Act, the National Watershed Protection and Flood

1	Prevention Act, and the Farm Bill, and worked with farmers and landowners in priority
2	watersheds across the state in other efforts such as the Mississippi River Basin Healthy
3	Watersheds Initiative and the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program; and
4	WHEREAS, the Louisiana office of soil and water conservation provides essential
5	services in cooperation with other state agencies, including the Louisiana Department of
6	Environmental Quality in conducting the Agricultural Solid Waste Management Program
7	and the Clean Water Act, Section 319 Agricultural Nonpoint Source Management Program;
8	the LSU Agriculture Center in delivering the Certified Prescribed Burn Manager and Master
9	Farmer programs; and with the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority in
10	implementing the Coastal Vegetative Planting Program; and
11	WHEREAS, many of these conservation programs and projects continue to provide
12	multiple public benefits by improving soil stability and fertility, water quality and quantity,
13	flood control, air quality, and terrestrial and aquatic wildlife habitat far beyond the scope and
14	geographic boundaries of the programs and projects implemented; and
15	WHEREAS, these conservation efforts have historically provided and continue to
16	provide a significant level of socioeconomic stability to many rural areas of the state; and
17	WHEREAS; ongoing, changing, and intensifying land uses in Louisiana underscore
18	the need to support continuation of efforts by the Louisiana office of soil and water
19	conservation to address persistent soil and water conservation needs in every Louisiana
20	parish and to improve water quality in our state's bayous, lakes, rivers, streams, coastal bays,
21	and estuaries and in the Gulf of Mexico.
22	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the House of Representatives of the
23	Legislature of Louisiana affirms its support for the Louisiana office of soil and water
24	conservation and its continued work to improve the state's agriculture, soil health, water
25	quality, and related natural resources.
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
27	to the Department of Agriculture and Forestry commissioner, Mike Strain.
