1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Terrance
3 Lewis.

4 WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound regret that the House of
5 Representatives has learned of the death, on May 10, 2023, of Terrance Lewis; and

6 WHEREAS, Terrance was born on November 25, 1957, in Monroe, Louisiana, to
7 Leon Lewis, Sr., and Winona Fitch Lewis; he was baptized as an infant at Little Flower of
8 Jesus Catholic Church and attended Little Flower Academy in his elementary and junior
9 high school years; he graduated from Wossman High School in 1977; and

10 WHEREAS, after high school, Mr. Lewis found employment at the Louisiana
11 Training Institute for Boys/the Swanson Center in Monroe for Youth, where he dedicated
12 twenty-eight years of state service before his retirement; and

13 WHEREAS, Terrance Lewis leaves to cherish his memory his son, Cedale Reed;
14 sisters, Leona R. Lewis, Zenona L. Stephens, Ardwyn L. Lewis, and Ilala K. Lewis; brothers,
15 Caryell J. Lewis, Lambert O. Lewis, and Gregory D. Stovall; uncles, Robert L.K. Allen, and
16 his wife Joan, and Frank Holmes, Jr., and his wife Denise; and a host of nieces, nephews,
17 cousins, extended relatives, and friends; he will be deeply missed but certainly never
18 forgotten.
