A RESOLUTION

To commend Metairie Park Country Day School students for their National French Awards 2022.

WHEREAS, the American Association of Teachers of French sponsors the only nationally recognized French exam each year, *Le Grand Concours*; and

WHEREAS, the exam is particularly challenging because it involves listening, reading and writing; many participants are native French speakers or attend French immersion programs; and

WHEREAS, many of the Metairie Park Country Day students placed in the top three categories in their respective levels: bronze, indicating the student placed in the 75th-85th percentile in the nation; silver, indicating the student placed in the 85th-95th percentile in the nation; and gold, indicating the student placed in the 95th percentile or higher in the nation; and

WHEREAS, in French 2, students earning silver awards were Manish Jain, Mason Kwon, Max Pollock, Charlie Kazour, and Laney Hebert; Oliver Parsi earned a gold award; and

WHEREAS, in French 3, Londyn Norwood was a bronze award winner; Pierce Hathaway and Minnie Mae August won silver; and Magdelena St. Louis, Winnie Goldenberg, and Bastien Sever won gold awards; and

WHEREAS, in French 4 there were two bronze winners, Clarisse Bernard Bitchatch and Raine Goldenberg; and four silver awards, Coco Goldenberg, Peetsie Goldenberg, Gabrielle White, and Mia Luparello; and

WHEREAS, all of these fine scholars are worthy of recognition for their hard work.
