A RESOLUTION

To commend the Anacoco High School boys' basketball team upon winning its first state championship.

WHEREAS, the Anacoco Indians captured the Class B title in a commanding 62-48 victory over Midland High School in the Louisiana High School Athletic Association Top 28 tournament, giving the Anacoco boys' basketball team its first state championship; and

WHEREAS, Head Coach Tracy Reese prepared the Indians by instilling in the team a work ethic that will continue to provide the confidence and skills needed to equip these young men for success in the future; and
