A RESOLUTION

2 To adopt House Rule 11.6(G) of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives, to 3 provide for the applicability of the requirements for certain entities to submit the 4 appropriation bill supplemental information form to receive funding. 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana 6 that House Rule 11.6(G) of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives is hereby 7 adopted to read as follows: 8 Rule 11.6. Appropriations bills; required information 9 10 G. The requirements of this Rule shall not apply to funding for or an 11 appropriation request from a voluntary council on aging, a public community water 12 system, or a volunteer fire department.

Abstract: Provides that the provisions of the House Rules relative to the appropriation bill supplemental information form shall not apply to funding for or an appropriation request from a voluntary council on aging, a public community water system, or a volunteer fire department.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

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<u>Present House Rule</u> requires any amendment to an appropriation bill which proposes to provide funding for an entity which is neither a budget unit nor a political subdivision of the state to have certain information regarding the recipient entity and the proposal to be provided in the appropriation bill supplemental information form and provides for the required content of the form. Requires the Clerk to maintain the information in an online, searchable database, available to the public via the Internet and to provide for the mechanism for making completed appropriation bill supplemental information forms available to all members of the House of Representatives and for the sufficient notification to the members of the availability of the information.

<u>Proposed House Rule</u> provides that the requirements of <u>present House Rule</u> shall not apply to funding for or an appropriation request from a voluntary council on aging, a public community water system, or a volunteer fire department.
