A RESOLUTION

To designate Tuesday, April 12, 2022, as Acadiana Red and White Day at the state capitol.

WHEREAS, community and economic development leaders understand the crucial role of higher education institutions in improving economic performance, workforce development, and the quality of life both at a regional as well as a state-wide level; and
