A RESOLUTION

To commend John "Lil John" Burkhardt for his leadership of Louisianans for Prison Alternatives and his notable contributions to criminal justice reform in the state of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, in 2016, a coalition of organizations and individuals from across Louisiana united around their common goal of ensuring the success of the Justice Reinvestment Initiative that was undertaken by Governor John Bel Edwards; and

WHEREAS, the coalition formalized under the banner "Louisianans for Prison Alternatives", or LPA, and John Burkhardt was tasked with coordinating the group; he did so with grace, wisdom, and boundless humor for the subsequent three regular sessions of the legislature; and

WHEREAS, during Mr. Burkhardt's tenure at LPA, the state of Louisiana ushered in historic reforms such as the ten reform measures included in the Justice Reinvestment Initiative package and the repeal of Jim Crow era laws allowing felony convictions based on non-unanimous jury verdicts and depriving convicted felons of their right to vote; and
