HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 79

INSURANCE/GROUP-STATE: Requests the division of administration to study the costs and benefits of insurance coverage for fire protection officers through the office of group benefits

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request the division of administration to study the costs and benefits for fire
3 protection officers to participate in life, health, or other insurance programs
4 sponsored by the office of group benefits.

5 WHEREAS, group benefits may provide parish or municipal governing authorities
6 with an opportunity to cost-effectively retain and recruit employees by providing meaningful
7 benefits that help to protect the financial independence and strength of fire protection
8 officers and their families.

9 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
10 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the division of administration to study
11 the costs and benefits for fire protection officers to participate in life, health, or other
12 insurance programs sponsored by the office of group benefits and to submit a report of its
13 findings and recommendations from the study called for in this Resolution to the House
14 Committee on Appropriations, the Senate Committee on Finance, and the David R. Poynter
15 Legislative Research Library no later than February 1, 2023.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in carrying out the purposes of this Resolution,
17 the division of administration may engage and solicit input, recommendations, and advice
18 from the Department of Insurance, the Professional Fire Fighters Association of Louisiana,
19 and the Group Benefits Policy and Planning Board within the office of group benefits.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
2 commissioner of administration.
