COMMENDATIONS: Commends the Reverend Clarence E. Glover, Jr., upon his many accomplishments on the occasion of his sixtieth birthday

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend the Reverend Clarence E. Glover, Jr., on his many accomplishments on the  
3 occasion of his sixtieth birthday.

4 WHEREAS, the Reverend Glover is one of America's most respected voices on  
5 issues pertaining to African American history and culture, intercultural relations, and racism,  
6 and is also noted for his seminars and lectures on Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and the civil  
7 rights movement; and

8 WHEREAS, in 1986, the Reverend Glover served as interviewer and consultant for  
9 "In Remembrance of Martin", a PBS documentary on the first national Martin Luther King,  
10 Jr., holiday observance; and

11 WHEREAS, the Reverend Glover has lectured at universities, colleges, conferences,  
12 and public, private, and governmental agencies throughout the United States and the  
13 Caribbean, including the National Conference on Racial and Ethnic Relations in Higher  
14 Education, the National Society of Black Engineers, the National Black Studies Conference  
15 of the U.S. Department of Education, Harvard University, Rutgers University, the University  
16 of Notre Dame, the University of Alabama, and the Internal Revenue Service; and

17 WHEREAS, the Reverend Glover was coordinator of leadership development for  
18 Dallas Independent School District (DISD); he also served as executive director of  
19 Multicultural Education for Dallas public schools, and as special assistant to the general  
20 superintendent, intercultural relations; and

1           WHEREAS, before coming to DISD, the Reverend Glover served as director of  
2 intercultural Education and Minority Student Affairs at Southern Methodist University  
3 (SMU), where he supervised and worked with coordinators of African American, Asian  
4 American, and Hispanic students in developing strategies for creating a positive intercultural  
5 atmosphere on campus among faculty, staff, and students; and

6           WHEREAS, from 1980 to 1990, the Reverend Glover was coordinator of  
7 Intercultural Programs and African American Student Affairs at SMU, where he was  
8 responsible for development of curriculum design and the implementation of the African  
9 American Studies course entitled "Black and White"; and

10           WHEREAS, while at SMU, the Reverend Glover was an adjunct professor for  
11 African American Studies from 1987 to 1993; and

12           WHEREAS, the Reverend Glover is responsible for drafting the diversity harassment  
13 policies for SMU and Dallas public schools, both of which were among the nation's first  
14 such policies in education; and

15           WHEREAS, the Reverend Glover is the recipient of the "M" Award, which is the  
16 most highly prized recognition bestowed upon students, faculty, staff, and administrators at  
17 SMU; and

18           WHEREAS, the Reverend Glover has a bachelor of arts degree from Grambling State  
19 University, as well as a masters of theological studies degree from the Perkins School of  
20 Theology at SMU, with a concentration in African American Religion and Culture, and is  
21 also a graduate of the Harvard University Graduate Institute on School Climate and  
22 Governance with a concentration in Moral Education and Human Development.

23           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
24 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Reverend Clarence E. Glover, Jr., for his  
25 many accomplishments on the occasion of his sixtieth birthday, and also commends him for  
26 his tireless work to assist segments of our society address multicultural issues.
