HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 96

A RESOLUTION

To commend Annie Carr for her years of service to public health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

WHEREAS, Annie Carr graduated from Southern University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, with a bachelor of science degree in food and nutrition before entering her dietetic internship program at Indiana University Medical Center in Indianapolis, Indiana, for six months; and

WHEREAS, following completion of her internship she entered graduate school at Indiana University/Purdue University at Indianapolis where she earned a master of education degree and became a registered dietitian; and

WHEREAS, her professional career began at the Marion County Health and Hospitals Corporation as a public health nutritionist for well baby clinics while still a graduate student; when a new federally funded program for high risk women and children called the Maternal and Infant Care Project was implemented in Marion County, she was selected as the public health nutritionist; and

WHEREAS, she later accepted a job at the Indiana Department of Public Instruction as the administrator of the Child Care Food Program and the Summer Food Service Programs, and she later became the nutrition educator at the Division of Food and Nutrition Programs; and

WHEREAS, she was selected as a public health nutritionist by the Division of Nutrition, National Center for Chronic Disease Prevention and Health Promotion, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and

WHEREAS, during her long and highly productive career she had the opportunity to serve globally on assignment in Tanzania for three months and Cameroon for eight weeks; and

WHEREAS, she is a member of the American Public Health Association, Food and Nutrition Section; her hobbies include traveling, gardening; and cooking; and

WHEREAS, Annie Carr merits a special measure of commendation for her outstanding achievements and singular contributions made during an exemplary career in public health.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend and recognize Annie Carr for her twenty-eight years of service to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention as well as her forty-five years of service to public health; does hereby express sincere and heartfelt appreciation for the tremendous pride and honor that Ms. Carr brings to Southern University and to the state of Louisiana; and does hereby extend to her best wishes for continued success and happiness in all her future endeavors.
