



1 Rampart, Bienville, City Park Avenue, Canal Boulevard, Weiblen Place, General Diaz  
2 Street, and Orleans Avenue; and

3 WHEREAS, the Alignment of Public Incentives for Strategic Outcomes report to the  
4 city of New Orleans, published in 2018, found that the establishment in 2011 of a tax  
5 increment financing strategy within one-fourth mile of the Lafitte Greenway would have  
6 generated eighteen million dollars over a fifteen-year period.

7 THEREFORE the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana requests  
8 the House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to study potential  
9 revenues that could be generated by establishing an economic development district in the  
10 Lafitte Greenway corridor in the city of New Orleans and to report its findings to the House  
11 of Representatives not later than November 15, 2023.
