#### SENATE BILL NO. 106

# BY SENATORS BARROW, DUPLESSIS, EDMONDS AND TALBOT

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 22:1047, relative to obesity treatment; to require coverage for severe obesity
3	treatments; to provide for requirements for coverage; to provide for definitions; to
4	provide for applicability; to require an evaluation from the Louisiana Department of
5	Health; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 22:1047 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1047. Required coverage for severe obesity treatment
9	A. A health insurance issuer offering health coverage plans in this state
10	that provides hospital, medical, or surgical benefits for individuals covered
11	under a respective plan shall provide coverage for medically necessary expenses
12	for diseases and conditions caused by severe obesity and treatment in
13	accordance with this Section.
14	<b>B.(1)</b> Subsections C, D, E, and F of this Section shall apply only to a
15	health insurance issuer offering health coverage plans in this state to the extent
16	services are covered by the Essential Health Benefits Benchmark Plan selected
17	by the state in accordance with applicable federal regulations.
18	(2) The Louisiana Department of Health shall evaluate bariatric
19	surgery, pre-operative psychological screening and counseling, behavior
20	modification, nutritional counseling, and post-operative follow-up, overview,
21	and counseling of dietary exercise, and lifestyle changes for coverage by the
22	Essential Health Benefits Benchmark Plan during its next review of the
23	Essential Health Benefits Benchmark Plan.
24	C. Treatment shall include but not be limited to bariatric surgery,
25	recognized by the American Society for Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery.
26	Treatment shall also include pre-operative psychological screening and
27	counseling, behavior modification, nutritional counseling, and post-operative

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1	follow-up, overview, and counseling of dietary, exercise, and lifestyle changes.
2	<b>D.</b> The insured shall be at least eighteen years of age to be eligible for
3	<u>bariatric surgery coverage. Prior to the treatment required to be covered by this</u>
4	Section, a health insurance issuer may require a covered person to successfully
5	complete a pre-operative period which may include counseling, nutritional
6	education, and other covered services to assist in preparation and evaluation for
7	successful treatment.
8	<b>E.(1)</b> The prescribing physician shall issue a written order stating that
9	treatment is medically necessary and in accordance with the patient
10	qualifications and treatment standards set forth by the American Society for
11	Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery or the American College of Surgeons.
12	(2) A health insurance issuer may restrict covered services pursuant to
13	this Section to those provided in facilities holding accreditation by the American
14	College of Surgeons and the American Society for Metabolic and Bariatric
15	Surgery's Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery Accreditation.
16	F.(1) A health insurance issuer may require that all covered services

2	insurance policy, or any other insurance contract of this type in this state,
3	including a group insurance plan, and a self-insurance plan. "Health coverage
4	plan" does not include a plan providing coverage for excepted benefits defined
5	in R.S. 22:1061, limited benefit health insurance plans, and short-term policies
6	that have a term of less than twelve months or the Office of Group Benefits
7	programs.
8	(3) "Severe obesity" means either of the following:
9	(a) A body mass index equal to or greater than forty kilograms per meter
10	squared.
11	(b) A body mass index equal to or greater than thirty-five kilograms per
12	meter squared along with an associated comorbidity including but not limited
13	to hypertension, cardiopulmonary conditions, sleep apnea, or diabetes.
14	Section 2. This Act shall apply to any new policy, contract, program, or health
15	coverage plan issued on and after January 1, 2025. Any policy, contract, or health coverage
16	plan in effect prior to January 1, 2025, shall convert to conform this Act on or before the
17	renewal date, but no later than January 1, 2026.
